Introduction to RMIT

The Research Manager Intensive Training (RMIT) programme is designed to boost research managers' professional development and increase their efficiency through carefully tailored sessions that combine a broad perspective with an individual approach.



RMIT's second course "Mastering research management" is aimed at research managers with 2 to 15 years of experience from any type of research performing or funding organisation, such as universities, universities of applied sciences, colleges, public or private research institutes, research & development companies, research funders and government agencies.
