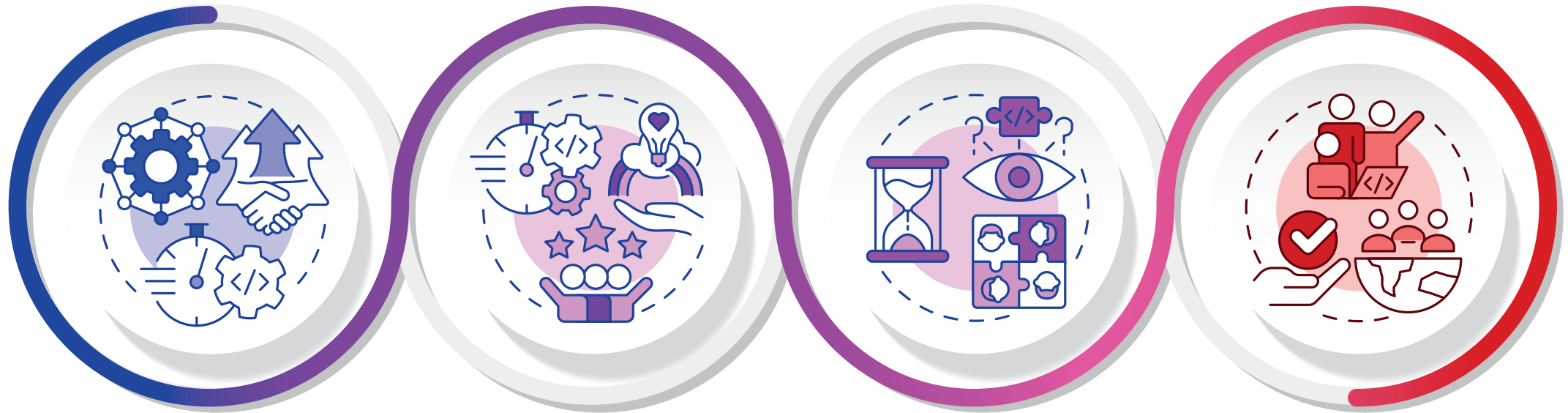


Research Manager Intensive Training – 1: New in the RM profession
